We're living in a busy world. A world of fast food and fast computers. We have instant coffee, express checkouts, and jiffy-lube oil changes. We're always in a hurry. We've got things to do, places to go, people to see. What we want, we want it now, like the fellow who prayed, "Lord, give me patience and give it to me NOW." America's rat race is summed up in I Kings 20:40, "busy here and there," We are busy here and there, aren't we? If you don't believe it, answer these questions: When was the last time...
