 who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek” (Romans 1:14–16).

Because we love the souls of men, we are not afraid to speak out against sin. We know that  
 passions of the flesh “wage war against the soul” (1 Peter 2:11).

Because we love the souls of men, we preach the need to follow Jesus. Jesus is the way, the  
 truth, and the life. “No one comes to the Father except through me” (John 14:6).

Because we love the souls of men, we point people to what is best. The Lord Jesus came to  
 bring us an abundant life (John 10:10). His yoke is easy, and His burden is light (Matthew 11:28  
 -30). He is the Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace (Isaiah  
 9:6). He is “our wisdom and our righteousness and sanctification and redemption” (1 Corin-  
 thians 1:30). We can do no better than to preach Jesus and Him crucified to every soul in every  
 place who will hear.
