I'M GOING HOME WITH YOU, TODAY

Luke 10:1-10

A stranger walks up to you suggesting going home with you, what would you say? "You wished," or "You are making a mistake pal." If persisted, you may wish to call law enforcements. On the other hand, an acquaintance abruptly suggests going home with you and instantly you start thinking about excuses because your home is in disarray. One wish is, to put off this unplanned visit for another time. Does this bring back any memories?

In his thirties, Jesus came in contact with a rich man who anxiously waited to have a clear view of him from the top of a fruit tree. This was the first time meeting Jesus. Though rich, he had a crooked personality and was disliked by most people, with the exception of those who served under him. However, **Jesus wanted to go home with him that day**. Without any hesitation, he said to our Lord, 'Come on!' The spectators were disappointed at Jesus willingness to hang out with him. Would we have objected? May be or maybe not.

As Jesus was relaxing and snacking with him at home, the rich man's heart convinced him to do the right thing. He volunteered to return more of what he stole from others and also declared to share his wealth with the poor. Jesus loved him when he saw him on that fig tree and now He approved of him among critics.... "Today, salvation has come to your house."

This once twisted man can now be proud of his real name, **Zacchaeus**, which means **CLEAN** in **Hebrew**. What a feeling of relief when Jesus accepts us for who we are?

Lessons gleaned

- 1. Our sins are not too bad not be forgiven by the Lord, no matter what the critics may say.
- 2. (1 Cor.6:9-11) If Christ welcomes sinners, who am I to stand in their way? (LK.19:10)
- 3. As Christ invites Himself to your home (heart), right at this moment, would you do what Zacchaeus did, by welcoming *Him?* (*Matt.10:32*)
